## Group 4: Return postage instructions

1. Package the samples securely into a box or sturdy bag. Record the dimensions and weight of the package.
2. Contact ChemCentre via email [samplereceivables@chemcentre.wa.gov.au](mailto:samplereceivables@chemcentre.wa.gov.au) or by calling 9422 9900. Please provide the following information:
  - a. The dimensions and weight of the package.
  - b. The collection address.
  - c. Your contact details (phone number and email address) as the person responsible for the package.
3. ChemCentre will arrange the pickup online and email you the Consignment note and manifest. Please attach these to the package.

Your samples are now ready for pickup.
